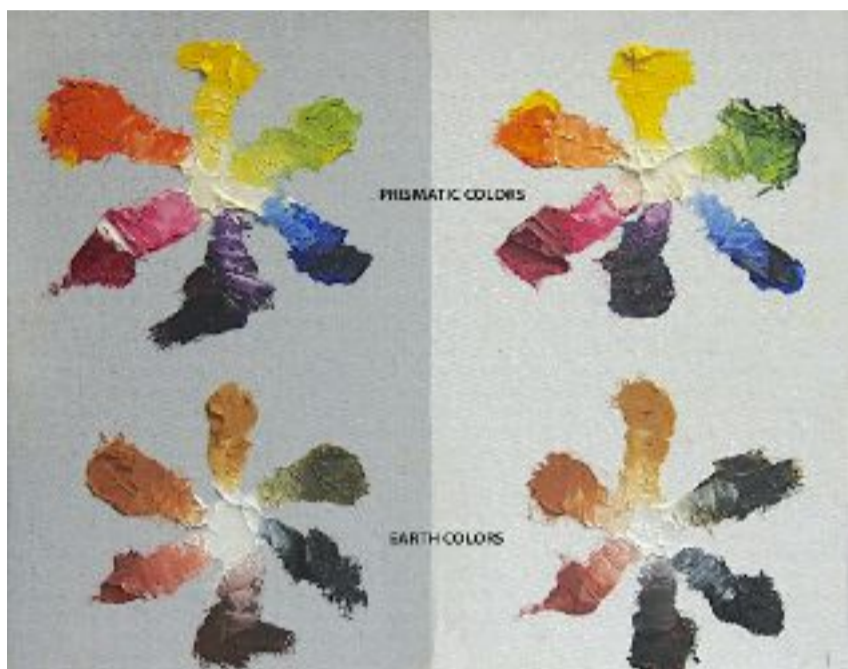

Dot will demonstrate her method of controlling the harmony of color in her paintings and her method of avoiding dull muddy color while depicting spatial atmosphere.

We have a very special event planned for our meeting in October. We're all artists or art enthusiasts. How often can you possibly be offered a FREE live model session? So, on October 27th, at 7 pm, after a short business meeting, you will have an opportunity to enjoy 2 live models so we can split into 2 groups and not be too crowded to see.

We are honored to have Jessica and Rodney to be our subjects for our live model session. This will be a clothed session and you will be able to draw, paint, sketch, use pastels, or whatever medium you love to use.

Take a break during the week and take advantage of this unique opportunity! Usually, live model sessions either have a cost or are closed sessions or worse, are so crowded that you can't get a good spot.

We will have 2 models, 2 areas and 2 sections of our cafeteria in which to view and paint (draw/ sketch/ photograph, etc).

Don't miss this chance-bring your supplies and let's roll up our sleeves and do what we do!

November 17:

George Thompson

We are delighted that George Thompson has agreed to show us how to begin the painting process using only two paint colors. This is *a* technique that can be used no matter what medium you employ.

To begin *a* painting, George will demo how to use *a* value scale thumbnail painting, using only black and white paint, to create *a* small preliminary painting. You will learn how to look at your photo, or at your scene, environment or location and translate that into the essential information that will create *a* painting. You will learn how to create abstract shapes which will convey value and composition. This technique is quick and so simple that you'll wonder how you ever started your art any other way!

Once you see this, and how easy it is to work out the proportions, values and composition, you will understand the value of this process. The next step is to do the same again in *a* limited palette of color. By the time you reach for the larger final canvas, all issues have been worked out and painting it will be *a* snap. Whether you use oil, acrylic, watercolor, pastel, pencils, graphite or paper, this can be applied to your medium.

You won't want to miss this opportunity to learn from an expert in our field.

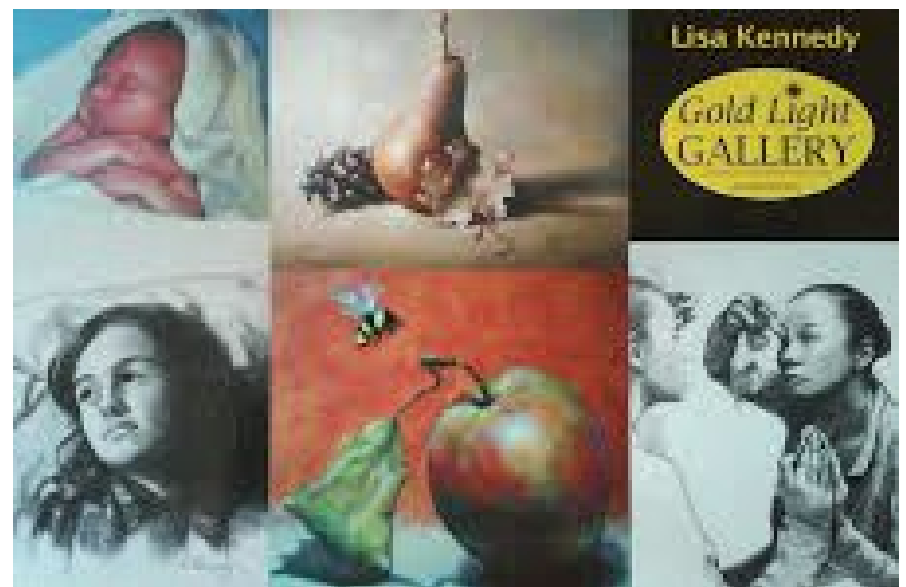

The LouisLong Gallery Above Penn Square Reading, PA - The ReadingFilmFEST (RFF) presents the first ever "Art of Film," a fine art exhibition featuring regional artists designed to highlight the theme of "FILM," create

awareness of the revamped film festival, and engage the community in the event. The opening of the exhibit will be held on Thursday, October 15, 2015, at the LouisLong Gallery Above Penn Square from 5:00 p.m.-8:00 p.m. with an awards ceremony scheduled for 6:45 p.m. The exhibit is free and open to the public and runs from October 15 - November 30, 2015. "The Art of Film" is a juried competition featuring professional artists and Berks County college students. Jurors are local art aficionado Robert P. Metzger, Ph.D., and Lauralynn White, Gallery Director of the GoggleWorks. Cash prizes totaling \$2000 will be presented to winning artists. Susan Biebuyck, Gallery Director of Studio B in Boyertown, PA, is the curator for the show. "We are excited to bring this new theme to our fine arts community and support our local film industry," Biebuyck offered. "We're always looking for new ways to express ourselves, and themed exhibits provide a great prompt for ideas. I am sure our artists will shine in this exhibition," she continued. Artists will be encouraged to submit work in all media. Interested artists can find a prospectus

The festival's organizers will facilitate a public art installation highlighting the work of several of the prize winners. The art work will be duplicated on banners and hung from lampposts on Penn Street bridge during the ReadingFilmFEST throughout November. "These banners will serve both as a public art display and a warm welcome to the attendees of the ReadingFilmFEST," said Tracy Schott, Festival Director.

In addition to hosting the exhibit opening, the Louis Long Gallery will present films on November 13 and November 14, 2015, serving as a venue for the film festival.
