Debra Pisacreta, a member of the Artists' Gallery in Lambertville, announces an opening for an artist to join the Gallery. For some background information about Artists' Gallery... There are 16 artists with a monthly fee of \$170. – no commissions on sales. Artists run the gallery which means each have small jobs to do and artists gallery sit once a month. The gallery is open from Thursday through Sunday 11-6. Each artist gets a wall to display art (they rotate every month) and a 2 person show in the feature room once a year. For the 4 winter months we do group shows in the feature room. The Gallery is located on Bridge Street in Lambertville. They also have arrangements with 3 restaurants in town, Caffe Galleria, Bell's Tavern, and It's Nutts. to display work. Each artist gets a 2 month show at one of the restaurants and there is no commission on sales. This is great exposure. Anyone interested can contact Debra at 609-915-2142. The artist would need to apply and submit a few paintings. Applications are reviewed at the monthly meetings - the next meeting is October 1.
